Any awards will continue throughout a pupil's time at Cheltenham College and may possibly be enhanced as he or she moves on to the Senior School at 13+.



Academic

Candidates who perform particularly well in the 11+ CE will be invited to sit the 11+ Academic Scholarship exam, comprising of Maths, English, Science and General Essay papers. This will involve more in depth problem solving as well as an opportunity for pupils to demonstrate their independent thinking skills.

Art

Candidates should bring in a portfolio of recent work on the day. It would also be good to see an extra-curricular interest. Drawing skills should be clearly evident and sketchbooks would be useful. On the day of the assessment each candidate will be expected to talk about his or her work as well as to take part in a Still-Life exercise lasting about one hour.

Design Technology

Candidates should bring examples of any three dimensional work which has recently been produced, together with any supporting drawings if possible. The assessment takes the form of a short practical task and an interview based on the material brought in.

Music

Two pieces will be required for the main instrument, along with the appropriate scales. Sight reading and aural tests will also be given. A second instrument and/or voice should also be offered and one prepared piece presented at the audition.

Sport

Candidates should have represented their school in at least two different sports in their age group's top team and, if possible, have also had Club experience. Evidence of potential is essential and a letter from your child's present games' coach should substantiate this.
