## 13+ Academic Scholarships

We offer a generous range of 13+ Scholarships and Exhibitions to recognise and reward academic excellence. Scholarships are awarded for exceptional performance or potential demonstrated in the 13+ Academic Scholarship papers; the quality of a Scholar might emerge across a paper, or in the way a candidate has handled particular problems.

In addition to our Academic Scholarships and Exhibitions, each year we award three named 13+ Academic Scholarships:

- The Lord James of Hereford Scholarship (this rewards all-round academic excellence and is awarded to the candidate who performs best overall in the Scholarship papers)
- The Prain Scholarship (this rewards particular ability in Science and Mathematics)
- The Old Cheltonian Society Scholarship (this is awarded solely to the children of OCs who show particularly high ability. It is not necessarily awarded every year).

All candidates for Academic Scholarships will be interviewed and will sit six or seven papers in the following subjects. Each paper will last 1 hour & 15 minutes:

- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- French AND / OR Latin
- General (Humanities) paper
- Verbal and non-verbal reasoning

## 13+ Non-Academic Scholarships



### Art

Art Scholarships are offered on the basis of a submitted portfolio of work, a short creative test, and an object drawing exam. The portfolio should cover as wide a range of materials as possible.

Closing Date: 3 February 2012

Assessment Date: 28 February 2012



### All-round

Candidates may not specifically apply for this award but at College's discretion. Pupils entering and performing well in at least two of the recognised Scholarship disciplines may be awarded an All-round Scholarship or Exhibition in their place.



### Design & Technology

Candidates must complete a set project, in the form of a themed mobile, with a supporting folder and range of design ideas. Paper, card, textiles, resistant materials and electronics can all be used.

### Drama

Candidates for this Scholarship must prepare two monologues (each lasting between 1 ½ and 2 minutes) and take part in a group workshop as well as a brief interview, during which candidates will be questioned about their own performance.

### Music

We offer a generous range of Music and Choral Scholarships to candidates who show musical potential and, above all, a genuine enthusiasm for music. Candidates should prepare two contrasting pieces and will be given sight-reading and aural tests.

Assessment Date: 31 January 2012



### Sport

Candidates should show outstanding sporting potential in any sphere of sport. Particular potential in at least one of College's main games is encouraged but ability in a combination of sports is also highly considered.

Closing Date: 14 October 2011

Assessment Date: 7-8 November 2011
