Dear Parents

Further to the Bursar's letter in April, I am writing to let you know that Council met at the end of June to consider, and approve, the College operating budget for the new financial year, which, like the academic year, starts on 1 September. This consideration includes, of course, the level at which fees will be set for the year ahead.

As you might expect, Council was careful to take proper account of the significant burden that school fees can represent for families, whilst also noting the difficulties caused by Covid over recent months, the freezing of fees last year and the inflation forecasts. We acknowledge that affordability can be a real challenge for many, and we do all we can to minimise any increase that may be necessary.

We continue to maintain our focus on keeping a tight rein on costs, whilst remaining committed to the quality of the education and pastoral care that we provide for your children. We believe that, bearing all of this in mind, we have, once again, set College's fees for the year ahead at a very competitive level.
